Dear Member,

I hope that you are all well and getting through this lockdown as best as you can. I'm sure that you are all missing Sunday morning worship and that you are missing having fellowship with your friends.

Now that we have entered Phase 2 of the lockdown, you may be wondering when will the church reopen as the Scottish Government announced that churches can now open for private prayer.

However, this phase comes with severe restrictions, social distancing and strict hygiene practices are to be put in place. The Church of Scotland has a strict risk assessment that needs to be completed and this has to be agreed by our Kirk Session and then by Presbytery. So, you can see that this is not going to be a quick process.

The virus is still in Scotland and the social distancing rules at present for private prayer would limit numbers in church at any one time to about 30-40 people. There is also the fear of a second wave.

The Kirk Session met by video-link to discuss the issue and reflect on the guidelines for reopening and they have wisely decided to be patient and not to rush into reopening. We have formed a small team, comprising of Bill McInnes, Jim Johnstone and myself to study the guidelines and put a plan in place that would satisfy the requirements of the Church of Scotland Risk assessment.

Phase 3 may come into place on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of July which would hopefully lift some more restrictions around social distancing in places of worship. But the Kirk Session want to satisfy itself that there will be no risks taken that will make the church a place where the virus might spread. So, it may well be Phase 4 before we think about reopening. Most churches are taking this cautious approach to reopening.

In the meantime, our online services will continue through the **Cadder Church YouTube channel** which is available through our church website. The website address is [www.cadderchurch.org.uk](http://www.cadderchurch.org.uk) and the services can be watched at any time during the week.
