Recycling - We have recently arranged recycling of ink cartridges deposited at the Church and South Hall and confirm that £107.95 has been donated to Christian Aid as a result. This brings the total raised for Christian Aid so far to £170.40, and we have only started this in late 2023.

Good News!! And we have saved countless ink cartridges heading to landfill. We have also recycled almost 3000 pairs of spectacles for Vision Aid. A great result!
